# Passports & visas

All travellers are responsible for securing necessary documentation.

## Passports

- Valid passports are required for all travellers. Passports may take up to 14 weeks to process.
- **Important note:** Passports must be valid for at least six months after our return date.

## Visas

- Non-Canadian citizens may require special visas or other travel documents.

# Payment Options

## Pay in full at enrollment

- Pay the entire balance at the time you enroll
- Payment methods accepted: Visa or MasterCard, chequing or savings account, or personal cheques.

## Automatic Payment Plan

- After you enroll with the \$199 non refundable deposit, payments are automatically deducted from your bank account.
- Chequing or saving account accepted
- Final payment extended up to one month before your tour

## Manual Payment Plan

- Receive invoices and make payments in less frequent installments
- Payment methods accepted: Visa or MasterCard, direct debit, or personal checks
- Accounts must pay \$199 upon enrollment; \$500 total paid 30 days after enrollment; and additional \$500 paid 90 days after enrollment
- Final payment deadline is 99 days before

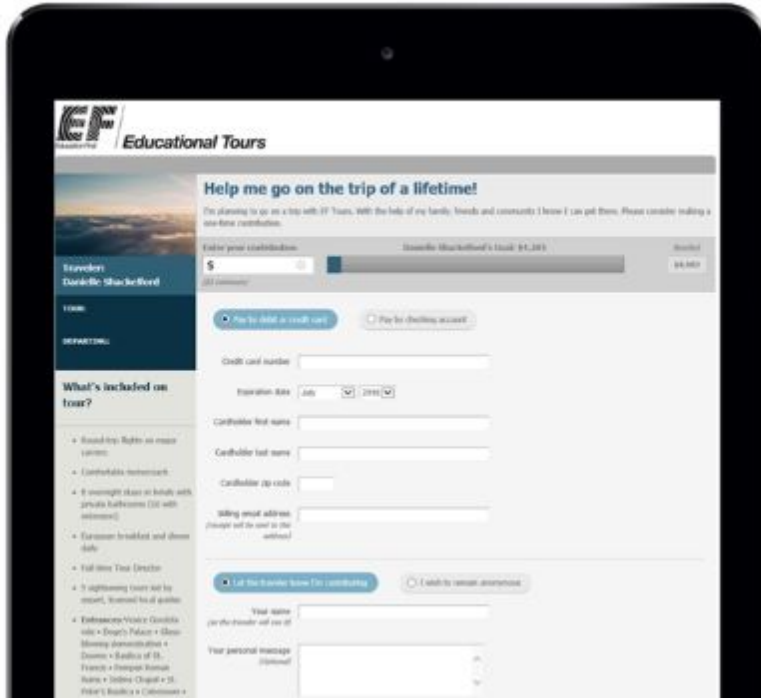
